

Call for papers

Dear colleagues,

The Open Text Group ([Grupo Texto Livre](#)) invites all for submission of papers to the 16th Virtual Meeting of Documentation in Free Software (XVI Encontro Virtual de Documentação em Software Livre - Evidosol) and 13th Congress of Language and Technology (XIII Congresso de Linguagem e Tecnologia - Ciltec-online).

The deadline for papers submissions by presenters or enrollment by attendees who would like to receive a certificate of participation is **October 1st, 2019**. The papers can be sent by the presenters in Portuguese, English or Spanish and must cover one of the following topics:

- Language and Technology,
- Computer-mediated Text,
- Documentation in Open Software,
- Hypertext,
- Journalism on the Internet;
- Blogs and Wikis,
- Education and Technologies,
- Media Education,
- Virtual Communities,
- Digital Inclusion and Open Culture,
- Translating and technologies.

The goal of the event is to extend the debate around the dialogue between language and technology by means of presentations of research studies, experiences and best practices. Since this is a virtual event, it surpasses geographical barriers, facilitating the participation of the interested parties.

The application for proposal submissions (articles) and 'listeners' can be made on the same system at the ['subscriptions' weblink](#). Please read the instructions for proposal submission carefully. Further details are available on the event's official website menu.

After to fill out your application, if you want to submit articles, you must fill out the form in the system, in the REGISTRATION space, and insert your complete article in .PDF according to the following instructions:

- Title should be all capital, centered and bold letters.
- The name (s) of the author (s), up to 5, and institution(s), must be justified on the right and in the same format as the body text.
- The abstract must be between 100 and 250 words.
- The keywords must be 3 to 5, with the first letter lowercase and separated by a semicolon (;).
- The sections should be at least three: introduction, development and conclusion. Feel free to change these section names.
- Section titles should be capitalized only the first letter; but all in bold, and sequentially numbered.
- References to be listed at the end of the text should be only those cited throughout the text and must comply with the ABNT standard.
- Your text should be between 6 and 8 pages, including attachments, references, etc.
- Formatting styles must be LibreOffice default for title, subtitle, caption, footnotes, etc.
- If you use proprietary software Word for Windows, your formatting should be: Times New Roman font, size 12pt; simple line spacing and 0pt before and after paragraphs; indent of 1.25 in first line of paragraphs; 1 space (ENTER) between each section; margins: upper and left with 3.0 cm, lower and right with 2.0 cm.
- Pages should be numbered in the upper right corner.
- The PDF should contain footnote from the title, only on the first page (change footer number to asterisk), with the following information in Times New Roman, size 10: XIII Congresso Internacional de Linguagem e Tecnologia Online.
- Figures should be inserted (not pasted) with caption and font.

The event will happen virtually in chat rooms and forum; and it's free of charge.

All the participants will receive a certificate of participation.
